Dear David, Sue, Bonnie and the St Mary's Church parishioners

On behalf of our little ones, we would like to thank you most sincerely for your incredibly generous donation of R1 943.32 (£105) that we received via a Western Union transfer. As so many of the children that we work with are experiencing hunger because of job losses due to Covid19 and the politically-orchestrated looting of the local malls, supermarkets and township stores, we have decided to use this funding to purchase fortified porridge for each child to take home. It costs us R16 (£0.86) per child per month for this porridge, so your amazing generosity will ensure that 122 of the most vulnerable children will go to bed with food in their tummies every night for the next month. At a time when so many are facing food security issues, this is such an incredible gift to give.

As you heard at Bonnie's presentation, Singakwenza educates adults who live in under-resourced communities to provide a variety of daily play opportunities for their preschool children. These fun and engaging activities, which maximise the sensitive period of the children's brain development, provide key foundational skills that are vitally important to thriving in formal education. All the resources that accompany this training are handmade from household packaging to ensure the long-term sustainability of the program, as well as making a wide variety of play activities available to children to encourage holistic development. Without appropriate nutrition, it is difficult for these little ones to concentrate and engage, so your kindness has ensured that they can make the most of our educational program.
